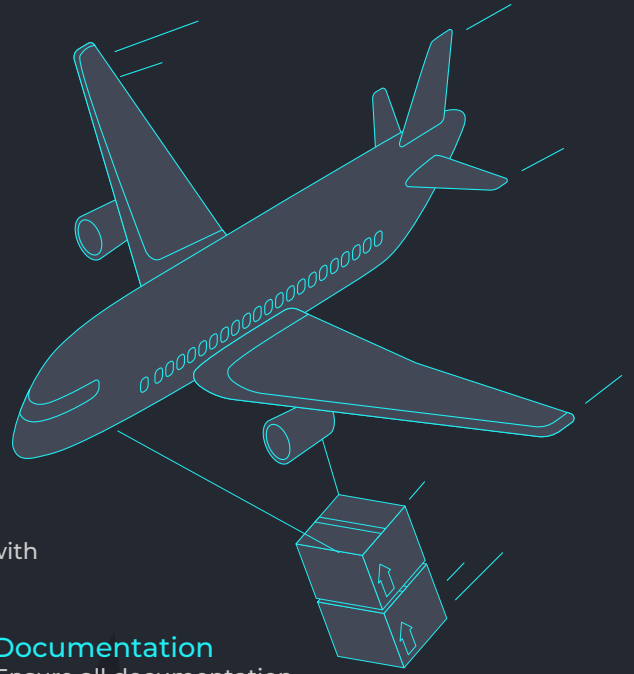


Importing and Exporting

Understanding your obligations and preparing for successful international shipping and fast customs clearance.

Pre-Flight Checklist

- 1 Commercial Invoice**
The commercial invoice provides details on the value, classification, origin, and destination of goods. It helps customs authorities to assess duties and taxes and ensures compliance with customs regulations.
- 2 Tarrifs and HS Codes**
Familiarise yourself with Harmonised System (HS) Tariff codes for proper classification.
- 3 Proof of Origin**
The origin of your goods can dictate how much duties and taxes you may need to pay.
- 4 Licences**
When shipping Dangerous Goods (DG) or other controlled and/or prohibited goods, make sure the shipment is fully compliant.



Import/Export Permits

Obtain necessary permits and licenses. Each country may have different requirements.

Commercial Invoice

Prepare detailed invoices with essential information.

Documentation

Ensure all documentation is complete and accurate.

Tariff Codes

Familiarise yourself with Harmonized System (HS) Tariff codes for proper classification.

Dangerous Goods

Declare Lithium Batteries and other DG's such as liquids and corrosive materials.

Value of the Goods

Accurately determine the value of goods for customs purposes.

Prohibited Goods

Be aware certain types of goods may be prohibited.

Goods and Services Tax

Understand GST obligations for imported goods.

Proof of Origin

Clearly state where the goods were made, and verify with appropriate documentation.

Duties and Taxes

Understand applicable customs duties, taxes, and fees.

Packaging and Labelling

Comply with packaging and labeling regulations.

Certification

Obtain and submit required certificates of origin.

Free Trade Agreements

Understand the benefits and rules of origin under FTAs.



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
